### ORDER OF THE EASTERN STAR

The Order of the Eastern Star is the largest Fraternal Organization in the world to which both Women and Men can belong. Dr. Rob Morris, the Poet Laureate of Masonry conceived the Order of the Eastern Star in 1850.

Our purpose and goal is to provide an organization where women and men with good moral and social character can reflect the spirit of fraternal love, and the desire to work together in Charity, Truth and Loving-kindness for the benefit of all mankind throughout the world.

**Eligibility for Membership:** Master Masons in good standing & female relatives of Master Masons:

Members (either active for three years or majority) of the International Order of Rainbow for Girls or of the International Order of Job's Daughters.

Must be at least 18 years of age.

The Master Mason does not need to belong to the Order of The Eastern Star in order for a woman to join. A Petitioner should be of good moral character, believe in a Supreme Being, be willing to assume the obligation of the Order and be able to attend the Ceremony of Initiation. A woman may use her affiliation with a Master Mason who has passed away, provided the Master Mason was a member in good standing at the time of his death.

**Dr. Morris created the Degrees of the Eastern Star** around the lives of five Biblical women: Jephthah's daughter (Adah), Ruth, Esther, Martha and "the elect lady" (Electa), each of whom are examples of heroic conduct and moral values. These heroines represent the Tenets of the Order which are Fidelity, Constancy, Loyalty, Faith and Love.

The Order of the Eastern Star is not a religion. It does not pretend to take the place of a religion, nor serve as a substitute for the religious beliefs of its members. Members of all religious faiths may belong to the Order of the Eastern Star. We only require a belief in the existence of a Supreme Being.

What does the Order have to offer? The Order of the Eastern Star provides us with a way of expressing compassion and concern for our Sisters and Brothers and loyalty to our friends, our Country, and our God. Each of us has an inner need to do something for others; however, sometimes it is difficult to determine just how to begin. We are truly dedicated to Charity, Truth and Loving-kindness.

The presiding officer usually plans some type of activity after each meeting. The Chapter and State also have numerous social activities for all members, their families and friends including bus trips, group vacations, dinners and dances.

# **HOW TO JOIN**

To proceed with joining the Order of the Eastern Star, please complete the petition attached and return to the person who gave it to you or the person whose name appears on the back of this brochure. You may also contact the

The Grand Secretary will contact the Worthy Matron and/or Secretary of the Chapter in your area who will be in contact with you. Following the reading of your Petition at a Chapter meeting, an Investigating Committee comprised of three members of the Chapter will be appointed by the presiding officer. Shortly thereafter, the members of the Investigating Committee will contact you to set up a time to meet with you. This is done to ask a few simple questions, provide you an opportunity to ask and receive answers to any questions you might have, and to verify your Masonic affiliation. The information the Investigating Committee receives will be reported to the Chapter.

If all the information is in order, the report of the Investigating Committee will be submitted to the Chapter at a Stated Meeting and a vote taken. If favorable, you will have been elected to receive the Degrees of the Order of the Eastern Star. The Secretary will notify you of the results of the election and the date of your initiation. Most Chapters meet once a month, therefore, you should be initiated at the next meeting.

## **OTHER QUESTIONS**

Is Eastern Star a secret society? No, secret societies are underground and hard to find. We are easily found within the community. While only members are allowed in a closed meeting, non-members, family and friends are always welcome at Open Installation of Officers and other social events.

Are there expenses with membership? Each member is required to pay annual dues to their Chapter. All other expenses are optional.

**Is there memory work?** There is memory work only if you become an Officer in your Chapter.

Is Eastern Star time consuming? After your initiation into the Order of the Eastern Star you may attend meetings as your time permits. However, the more you participate and become involved, the more you will receive from our Order.
